Donations and Membership Fees

Donations and membership fees help meet the financial obligations of support services that are not fully covered by government contracts. These funds go towards:

- Summer Camps and excursions
- Existing donation-based residential & community inclusion services
- Unfunded short-term and long-term support services for people with disabilities and families
- Special equipment and renovations
- Property development & maintenance
- Assistance in securing affordable housing
- Recruitment and training of volunteers
- Employment of full and part-time staff for Family Support Services, Employment Services and Supported Independent Living

Spending of funds is confined to Board approved services and purchases. Each gift designated toward an approved service is used as designated with the understanding that when any given need has been met, designated gifts will be used where most needed. Gifts are acknowledged and receipted with a tax deductible receipt. Bethesda is a charter member of the Canadian Council of Christian Charities (CCCC).
