- Reality: Government funds are restricted to specific services for individual recipients, leaving key needs unfunded.


2. WHAT GOVERNMENT FUNDING COVERS

- Staff wages for direct support and administrative support
- ✓ Some basic housing needs and vehicle expenses

*CLBC, or Community Living BC, is the provincial agency responsible for adults with intellectual and development disabilities. Other funding sources: BC Housing, MCFD, Fraser Health

- Support for families
- Summer camps
- Services for people not eligible for government funding


And Where Donations Step In
